With this sermon series, I want to help ConneXions members know what sin is, what to avoid and seek help from, what to confess, and how to grow and know Jesus even better!

Christ has had victory over sin and came to destroy it!

How can we join Jesus in what He's doing in this area?

Main points:

John 14:6 – Jesus is the Truth. Not just a truth, but the Truth. He's what true humanity looks like.

1 John 3:18 – Christ came to destroy sin!

Hebrews 4:15 – He was acquainted with, and overcame, every kind of human temptation.

Luke 2:52 – He “bent back” human nature to be what God intended it to be.

2 Cor 5:21 – He didn't just overcome sinning. He became our sin and overcame its ultimate penalty for humanity.

Romans 1:18-25 – God loves us, but hates sin. This provides a good starting list for what Paul saw as behavior that “misses the mark.”

Conclusion: Christ has won the victory. Sin did not “win.” And we don't have to let “sinning” keep on “winning” in our lives today.
