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Ezekiel/Revelation Part 3²

So we did Revelation 21, and found some interesting ConneXions with the prophecies in the book of Ezekiel. We actually found some embellishments that weren't in that prophecy. Amazing material. So now we'll go into Revelation 22, and I'll use the same format. Simply study the Scripture, absorb it, but also look for clear cut connections to the material in Ezekiel. I'll try to dig up some summary statements about the connection between the two. God is so amazing, and I love being in God University---the everyday study of His amazing word. Of course, in the Presence of the Living Word, Jesus. Enjoy!!

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I'll pick up about where I stopped yesterday, with only a bit of an overlap.

Revelation 21

22 I did not see a temple in the city, because the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple. 23 The city does not need the sun or the moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gives it light, and the Lamb is its lamp.

This is a huge concept biblically, especially in the writings of John. Look at these Scriptures.

John 1:4

In him was life, and that life was the **light** of all mankind.

John 1:5

The **light** shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

John 1:7

He came as a witness to testify concerning that **light**, so that through him all might believe.

John 1:8

He himself was not the **light**; he came only as a witness to the **light**.

John 1:9

The true **light** that gives **light** to everyone was coming into the world.

See sidebar. God does more than just give us light. He enlightens us---brightens us up, literally. He is like the sun, we are like the moon. As we mirror His glory, we are lightened up.

John 3:19

This is the verdict: **Light** has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of **light** because their deeds were evil.

John 3:20

Everyone who does evil hates the **light**, and will not come into the **light** for fear that their deeds will be exposed.

John 3:21

But whoever lives by the truth comes into the **light**, so that it may be seen plainly that what they have done has been done in the sight of God.

John 5:35

John was a lamp that burned and gave **light**, and you chose for a time to enjoy his **light**.

So here is a significant concept. John was a "vessel" who burned and gave light. He wasn't the light. But he was a

An alternate translation of John 1:9:

(CLV) Jn 1:9

It was the true *light—which is enlightening every *man—coming into the world.

to shed rays, i.e. to shine or (transitively) to brighten up (literally or figuratively).

(CLV) 2Co 3:18

Now we[/] all, with [°]uncovered [°] face, mirroring [°] the Lord's glory, are being transformed [°] into the same image, from glory ^{io} to glory, even as from the Lord, the spirit.

vessel in whom was the light. Jesus is the "Lamp" of the City in Revelation---the container in which the "Light" (that He also is shines). That is huge! The Word became flesh. He not only only was the Light of Life, He was the created "vessel" or container in which the light could shine. That supports Genesis 1 being the first incarnation of Christ.

John 8:12

[*Dispute Over Jesus' Testimony*] When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the **light** of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the **light** of life."

John 9:5

While I am in the world, I am the **light** of the world."

John 11.9

Jesus answered, "Are there not twelve hours of daylight? Anyone who walks in the daytime will not stumble, for they see by this world's **light**.

John 11:10

It is when a person walks at night that they stumble, for they have no **light**."

John 12:35

Then Jesus told them, "You are going to have the **light** just a little while longer. Walk while you have the **light**, before darkness overtakes you. Whoever walks in the dark does not know where they are going.

John 12:36

Believe in the **light** while you have the **light**, so that you may become children of **light**." When he had finished speaking, Jesus left and hid himself from them.

Wow. I want to be one of the Children of Light. See Ephesians Scripture in the second column.

John 12:46

I have come into the world as a **light**, so that no one who believes in me should stay in darkness.

24 The nations will walk by its light, and the kings of the earth will bring their splendor into it.

So there will be nations and splendor to be brought into it. Creation was meant to endure forever and be "liberated from its bondage to decay."

Romans 8

²⁰ For the creation was subjected to frustration, not by its own choice, but by the will of the one who subjected it, in hope ²¹ that the creation itself will be liberated from its bondage to decay and

Ephesians 5

⁸ For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light ⁹ (for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth) ¹⁰ and find out what pleases the Lord. ¹¹ Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them. ¹² It is shameful even to mention what the disobedient do in secret. ¹³But everything exposed by the light becomes visible—and everything that

EZEKIEL CONNEXION: The Ezekiel vision has a temple. Is that "vision" describing something about God, where perfect sacrifices in a perfectly symmetrical temple are being made always? I've been calling that temple a prophetic parable of Jesus, whoever lives to intercede for His people as their High Priest, always offering Himself, the fulfillment of all sacrifices, on our behalf.

The gates of this city are never shut. Always open. And there is no night there. The glory and the honor of the nations are brought into it.

We'll continue and try to summarize and dig out some commentaries on this next time.
