Then Jacob called for his sons and said: "Gather around so I can tell you what will happen to you in days to come.

This can refer to the future in general (see text box Scripture) but primarily refers to the Messianic era. In a real sense, the last days began with the first coming of Christ and will be fulfilled at his second coming.

It occurs in passages that depict the coming of both Jews and Gentiles to Jerusalem (Zion) in the last days.

## Hebrews 12:22

But you have come to Mount **Zion**, to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem.

Some believe that the peace described in this passage has been inaugurated through the coming of Christ and the preaching of the Gospel and will be consummated at the return of Christ. Some believe that this is solely a prophecy of conditions during a future reign of Christ on earth.

"Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD,

to the temple of the God of Jacob. He will teach us his ways,

so that we may walk in his paths." The law will go out from Zion, the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

<sup>3</sup> He will judge between many peoples

and will settle disputes for strong nations far and wide.

They will beat their swords into plowshares

and their spears into pruning hooks.

Plowshares as we know them did not exist in those days. Here what is called a plowshare was actually an iron point mounted on a wooden beam.

But the larger point is that what was used to kill is now going to be used prepare soil for the planting of seed.

I want quickly consider what is said about "swords" in the New Testament.

### 1. Matthew 26:52

Put your **sword** back in its place," Jesus said to him, "for all who draw the **sword** will die by the **sword**.

### 2. John 18:10

Then Simon Peter, who had a **sword**, drew it and struck the high priest's servant, cutting off his right ear. (The servant's name was Malchus.) Jesus commanded Peter, "Put your **sword** away! Shall I not drink the cup the Father has given me?"

### 3. Romans 13:4

For the one in authority is God's servant for your good. But if you do wrong, be afraid, for rulers do not bear the **sword** for no reason. They are God's servants, agents of wrath to bring punishment on the wrongdoer.

### 4. Ephesians 6:17

Take the helmet of salvation and the **sword** of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

### 5. Hebrews 4:12

For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged **sword**, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

Nation will not take up sword against nation, nor will they train for war anymore.

## Perhaps even verbal war!
