

I find it interesting that the Lord speaks inanimate things. Jesus used to speak to fevers, the wind and the waves,³ and they "obeyed."⁴

For the LORD has a case against his people;

he is lodging a charge against Israel.

³ "My people, what have I done to you?

How have I burdened you? Answer me.

This sounds like we hurt God's feelings. I bet we do. And He has the right to ask.

That phrase is repeated frequently in Exodus and all of Scripture. Let me look up a

few.

Exodus 3:17

And I have promised to bring you up **out of** your misery in **Egypt**

Exodus 13:14

'With a mighty hand the LORD brought us out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.

Exodus 20:2

"I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.

Leviticus 25:38

I am **the** LORD your God, who brought you **out of Egypt** to give you **the land of** Canaan and to be your God.

Deuteronomy 8:14

then your heart will become proud and you will forget the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.

It is repeated over and over again in Scripture. God brought His people (and Israel) out of the land of Egypt and out of slavery. He brought us to the land of Canaan to give it to us and to be our God.

Here's what else He did. He gave them leaders.

I sent Moses to lead you,

also Aaron and Miriam.

This says that He gave them three leaders---two males, one female. Interesting! A lady is listed as a leader!

⁵ My people, remember what Balak king of Moab plotted

and what Balaam son of Beor answered.

When Balaam sought a curse over Israel, the Lord wouldn't let him give it! Even though he offered him fees of divination, but he couldn't curse them! God would not let him. In fact, he blessed them four times (Numbers 23-25). Later on, in Jude 1:11 talked about his madness, and his desire for reward.

Remember your journey from Shittim to Gilgal,

that you may know the righteous acts of the LORD."

We will stop the study here today, and pick up on the next part about sacrifices and offerings that conceptually makes an important reappearance in the New Testament. Hebrews 10:5-7 New International Version

⁵ Therefore, when Christ came into the world, he said:

"Sacrifice and offering you did not desire,

but a body you prepared for me;

⁶ with burnt offerings and sin offerings

you were not pleased.
